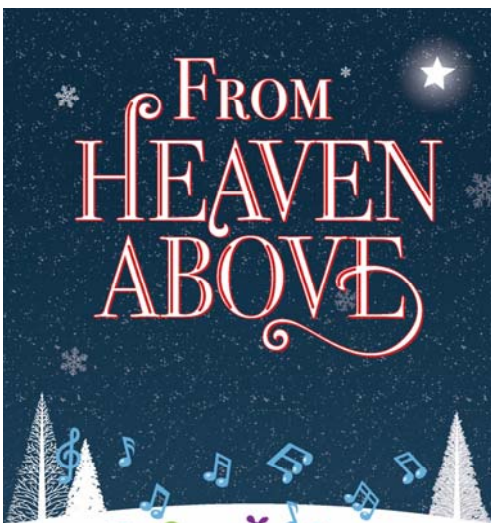




Advent will be here before we know it!
